Highlights in your term of office

1- I'm working with 4 coordinators: new club community coordinator, new club corporate coordinator, club sponsor and mentor coordinator, Open house coordinator.

2- We are following-up closely with Leads that are working on the process to get chartered, such as:

- CGT Lesotho /Division S/ Corporate Club: Charter forms and invoice sent to the company
- Debswana/Division O/ Corporate club: We need to register TI as a vendor and there are documents and information that need to be completed (need help from CGD and DD)
- Peach Payments / Division H/L/ Corporate: Met with HR and provided documentation. HR present at company's towhall, they have more then 20 interested future members. Launch meeting needs to be arranged.
